- **CHANGE OF HOURS** – Please note that the gallery hours have changed so as to be consistent with the other galleries in Albert Street. We now open at 11am and close at 5pm, from Wednesday to Saturday.
- **PARKING** – Clients should note that parking difficulties in Albert Street will very shortly be alleviated by the Richmond Council, who are in the process of altering the present “All Day” parking to “2 Hour” parking.
- **GEOFFREY BARTLETT AT THE NGV** – The major survey of Geoffrey Bartlett’s sculpture will open at the National Gallery of Victoria (Federation Square) on Friday 20 July 2007. Geoffrey has let me know that the show will be available to preview between 5 – 6 pm, that is i.e. 1 hour prior to the official opening on that day. Clients who may have an interest in purchasing Bartlett’s work should contact us at Albert Street in order to be placed on that invitation list, as new work will be for sale during the run of the exhibition.
- **GEOFFREY BARTLETT AT JOHN BUCKLEY GALLERY** – During the course of the National Gallery of Victoria survey Geoffrey will also show new work at 8 Albert Street.
- **SOMETHING OLD, SOMETHING NEW: THE SCULPTURE SHOW** – As a warm up to Geoffrey Bartlett’s NGV survey, the John Buckley Gallery will present a comprehensive exhibition of sculpture, both large and small; across several generations. Early works by Anthony Pryor (now rare); Rosalie Gascoigne and John Davis will feature; as will important early works by Callum Morton, Ricky Swallow, and Nick Mangan.

The exhibition will also include important pieces by gallery artists Geoffrey Bartlett, Bruce Armstrong, Augustine Dall’Ava and Peter D Cole.

All works will be fully illustrated on the website and, as with many of our recent shows, we will be previewing for almost a week (from approximately 12 July 2007) before the opening. Clients particularly interested in sculpture should phone to make an appointment to view early.
